BIBLICAL PRAYERS FOR OUR CHILDREN

1. Pray that I as a father, uncle, grandparent, mentor or future father would become the Godly man that God has always wanted me to be and that God would help reconcile my family. (Malachi 4:6).
2. Pray that our children would come to salvation through faith in Jesus Christ (1 Timothy 2:3-4).
3. Pray that they would honor and obey us as their parents as well as those in authority over them. (Ephesians 6:1-3, Hebrews 13:17)
4. Pray that the Lord would surround them with Godly friends and role models. (I Corinthians 15:33, Proverbs 13:20, 27:17).
5. Pray that the Lord would implant into their hearts a hunger and thirst for Him. (Psalm 42:1-2).
6. Pray that the Lord would give them the Spirit of wisdom and revelation so that they might know Him better (Ephesians 1:17).
7. Pray that the eyes of their hearts would always be enlightened in order that they might know the hope to which he has called them. (Ephesians 1:18).
8. Pray that they would always follow the truth and reject the lies of Satan. (Proverbs 22:3, Titus 2:11-12).
9. Pray that they would bear much fruit for God's glory. (Galatians 5:22-23, Ephesians 2:10, I John 3:16:18).
10. Pray that they will flee temptation. (I Corinthians 10:13, 2 Timothy 2:22-26).
11. Pray that they would use their gifts and talents to honor the Lord. (Proverbs 16:3, 1 Corinthians 10:31).
12. Pray that they would have freedom from fear as they trust in the Lord. (Psalm 56:13, 2 Thessalonians 3:16, 2 Timothy 1:7).

13. Pray that they would keep themselves sexually pure for their future mates. (I Corinthians 10:8, Hebrews 13:4).
14. Pray that the Lord would bring Godly mates into their lives. (2 Corinthians 10:5, Philippians 4:8).
15. Pray that they would take captive every thought and make it obedient to Christ. (2 Corinthians 10:5, Philippians 4:8).
16. Pray that they would become more like Him. (Romans 8:28-29).
